- Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) Unit 1 - Possible Falsification of Reactor Coolant System Inventory Leak Rate Tests (includes Supplemental Report) (#1-83-028);
- General Public Utilities Nuclear Alleged Failure to Provide Beta and RHR Consultant Reports to the NRC in a More Timely Fashion (#1-83-013); and
- General Public Utilities Nuclear (GPUN) Possible Training Irregularities (#01-84-004).

On April 26, 1984 there were two Commission meetings devoted to these reports. At the first meeting the Office of Investigations summarized the reports. At the second meeting the NRC staff presented its evaluation of the reports. We are also providing you with copies of the transcripts of those meetings.

As announced previously, at a future date the Commission will provide the parties with a draft management decision for comment. That draft decision may rely in part on OI's reports and the April 26 briefings. Hence the parties in commenting on the draft decision should also consider these reports and Commission meetings.
