By letter dated July 19, 1995, you applied for an amendment to the Technical Specifications for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant Unit 2, Facility Operating License No. 79. The proposed change would have revised the technical specification surveillance requirements and bases to incorporate alternate steam generator tube plugging criteria at tube support plate intersections. The approach was similar to guidance given in Generic Letter 95-05, "Voltage-Based Repair Criteria for Westinghouse Steam Generator Tubes Affected by Outside Diameter Stress Corrosion Cracking." Subsequently, by letter dated September 7, 1995, you withdrew the amendment request.
