This amendment consists of changes to the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated May 8, 1995, as supplemented by letter dated July 11, 1995.

The amendment changes Sections 2.3, 3.1, 3.2, 3.3 and 3.6 of the Technical Specifications in accordance with the guidance of Generic Letter (GL) 93-05, "Line Item Technical Specifications Improvements to Reduce Surveillance Requirements for Testing During Power Operation," dated September 27, 1993. The changes are consistent with Station operating experience and NUREG-1366, "Improvements to Technical Specifications Surveillance Requirements," dated December 1992. In addition, a change is made to TS Section 3.1 in accordance with the Commission's Final Policy Statement on Technical Specifications Improvements for Nuclear Power Reactors. Also, changes are made to the TS sections identified above for clarity and to correct administrative errors.

A copy of our related Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next biweekly Federal Register notice.
