ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE SUMMARY

On January 15, 1992, representatives from Duke Power Company (DPC) met with the NRC in the Region II Office in Atlanta, Georgia to discuss recent configuration control problems at Catawba.

Opening remarks were made by J. . Milhoan, Deputy Regional Administrator. The purpose of the meeting and a general outline of the NRC Enforcement Policy were given by G. R. Jenkins, Director, Enforcement and Investigation Coordination Staff. J. R. Johnson, Deputy Director, Division of Reactor Projects, gave a summary of the issues involved.
