Reference is made to the letter of this Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, dated June 5, 1984, relative to the unresolved safety generic issue A-46, Seismic Qualification of Equipment in Operating Plants. The Staff was requested "to provide in affidavit form, a full and detailed explanation of why it is acceptable to permit Wolf Creek to operate in the face of this safety issue under study."

Lee, both NRC Staff members, which explain the Staff position on unresolved generic safety issue A-46 (which applies only to the seismic qualification of equipment in operating plants and not applicable to Wolf Creek), and the measures which will be taken prior to any fuel load at Wolf Creek.
