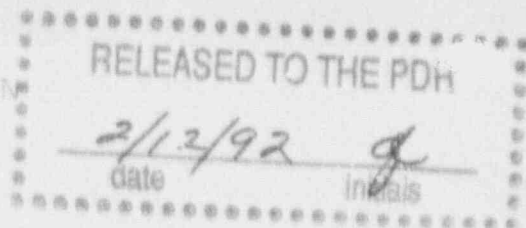

SUBJECT: SECY-92-014 - IMPLEMENTATION DATE FOR REVISED  
10 CFR PART 20

The Commission (with Commissioners Rogers, Curtiss, Remick and de Planque agreeing) has decided to delay the implementation date for a period of one year to January 1, 1994 (consistent with the date for implementation by Agreement State licensees). The Chairman would have preferred that the implementation date not be delayed. The staff should initiate the necessary rulemaking to delay the implementation date for the revised 10 CFR Part 20 to January 1, 1994. In keeping with the intent of the EPA-NRC MOU, the staff should notify and consult with EPA regarding the change in implementation date for revised Part 20, stressing the Commission's desire to have a firm basis for enforcement at the time the rule is fully implemented. The staff should inform the Commission of EPA's views before publishing the proposed rule.
