Dear Mr. Perry:

We have received your letter, dated January 9, 1992, responding to the subject Notice of Violation issued on November 29, 1991. We have reviewed your corrective actions and have no further questions at this time. These corrective actions will be examined during future inspections.

With regard to the first supplemental issue that we requested you address, we understand that the results of the inspection of the wall thickness of the fuel oil storage tanks did not identify any wall thinning. We have no further questions at this time. With regard to the second issue, we understand that you have not yet completed developing plans to improve the overall performance and reliability of the fire water supply system, and the fire pump diesels in particular. We would appreciate your providing the resident office with an outline of your plan, including dates when you expect to complete the actions, after you have completed your evaluations.
