NRC Region III has received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) letter dated December 16, 1991, and associated final exercise evaluations of the offsite portion of the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant's emergency preparedness exercise conducted on May 8, 1991. Offsite participation included the State of Ohio and Counties of Ottawa and Lucas.

FEMA concluded that the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness at the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Plant are adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency at the site. As a result, the approval of offsite emergency preparedness under FEMA Rule 44 CFR 350 will remain in effect.

You are requested to followup with offsite officials on the status of any outstanding items identified by FEMA.
