On July 18, 1991, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) 91-11, which contained the staff resolution of Generic Issues 48 and 49. The GL required that licensees certify that procedures exist which contain time limitations and surveillance requirements for vital instrument buses (VIB), inverters or other onsite power sources for VIB, and tie breakers. If procedures do not exist, a justification demonstrating the reasons why the controls are not needed is required.

By letter dated January 14, 1992, Entergy Operations, Inc., responded to the GL and indicated that procedures for time limitations and surveillance requirements are in place at its site.

The staff has reviewed the response and finds that it meets the reporting requirements set forth in GL 91-11. This completes the staff's activities on TAC No. M82485.
