On January 31 - February 24, 1984, NRC inspected activities authorized by NRC Operating License No. DPR-72 for your Crystal River 3 facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

The inspection revealed no violations of NRC requirements. However, certain activities having safety significance appeared to deviate from a commitment to the NRC. The deviations and elements to be included in your response are presented in the enclosed Notice of Deviation.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in NRC's Public Document Room unless you notify this office by telephone within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of the letter.
