Commitment Completion Date Revision

The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC Staff of a revised completion date for a commitment made in Reference 2 above. The commitment made in Reference 2 states:

"Alternate Shutdown isolation function procedures will be revised by September 1, 1995."

The revised commitment is as follows:

"Alternate Shutdown isolation function procedures will be revised by March 1, 1996."

The procedures are required to be performed on an 18 month surveillance frequency, with the next required performance in March of 1996. Therefore, delaying the procedure revisions will not adversely impact system performance or surveillance activities.

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This commitment due date revision was discussed on September 1, 1995, with Mr. Tony Vegel, the Fermi 2 Senior Resident Inspector, and Mr. Ron Gardner, of the Region III Division of Reactor Safety.
