SUBJECT: REVIEW OF ADVANCE CHANGE NOTICE 10-5 TO THE CLINTON STATION'S  
EMERGENCY PLAN

Dear Mr. Cook:

In February 1995, Region III received Advance Change Notice (ACN) 10-5 regarding select portions of the Clinton Station's emergency plan. We have reviewed these revisions and determined that, with one exception, they are acceptable and do not decrease the effectiveness of your emergency planning.

ACN 10-5 included acceptable refinements to some event classification criteria. Adequate descriptive information was added regarding the seismic monitoring system.

ACN 10-5 also indicated that a chemistry technician would be deleted from the onshift emergency organization during off-hours. We understand that your plan to replace that onshift technician with an oncall technician were not implemented. Pending completion of a generic reassessment of emergency organization staffing guidance, it is premature to determine whether your proposed change regarding the availability of a chemistry technician would be acceptable.
