ORDER CORRECTING SCHEDULE FOR PROPOSED FINDINGS ON NEPA SEVERE ACCIDENT CONTENTIONS

At the June 20, 1984 hearing session (transcript not yet received), the Board set a schedule for the filing of proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law on the NEPA severe accident contentions. That schedule did not correctly implement the May 24, 1984 agreement which, inter alia, provided that the NRC Staff would file its findings before findings are filed by LEA, the City of Philadelphia and the Commonwealth. Tr. 11,607-609.

Applicant's Counsel alerted the Board to this discrepancy on June 21, 1984. The Board appreciates this prompt action by Applicant's counsel, thereby permitting the Board promptly to correct the schedule, as follows:

July 6: Applicant's proposed findings

July 16: NRC Staff's proposed findings

July 26: LEA, City and Commonwealth proposed findings

August 6: Applicant's and Staff's reply findings (See

Tr. 11,607-608)

All dates are received dates. The page limit established on the record apply. They are 35 pages for the proposed findings in LEA's contentions and 35 pages for the City's issues 13 and 14 (15 pages for the replies). Tr. 11,906. The page limit for the proposed findings on City-15 is 30 pages (15 pages for the replies).
