This letter constitutes Edison's formal response to Intervenor's First Request to Edison for Production of Documents. We have already made available to you for inspection and copying a great quantity of documents. These documents were produced in response to categories 1 through 9 and 11 through 16 of your document request. Please be advised that in the event we discover any additional documents which are responsive to these categories we will immediately make them available to you.

As far as your other document request categories are concerned, Edison objects to them on the following grounds:

Category 10 - Edison objects to this request on the basis that the documents called for constitute work product and are excluded from discovery by Rule 26(b)(4) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

Categories 17-36 - Edison objects to each of these requests on the basis that the documents called for are irrelevant in that they are not within the scope of presently scheduled hearings on the Byron Station.


