Gentlemen:

This letter is a reply to the notice of violation in your letter dated December 26, 1991.

The Security Plan was revised in July 1990 (typographical and editorial changes) but the changes were approved only at the Reactor Utilization committee Meeting on August 24, 1990. That period was a time of transition in that the Director had retired in 1990 and returned as Associate Director under the State's 75-Day Rule. After the meeting in August, I assumed that the Associate Director would communicate the changes to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

It was only at your inspection that I found it not to be so. Also, at that time, we as committee members were not aware of the two-month notification deadline.

The corrective action is that I have submitted the revisions to NRC headquarters and Region 1 for review in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(P).

In order to avoid a reoccurrence in the future, I will inform the Reactor Utilization Committee of the requirements of 10CFR, Part 50.54. After future approvals, one person will be assigned to communicate to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the deadlines will be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
