1. Scope of Work

Provide the NRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement (IE) with assistance in addressing open NRC inspection activities required prior to fuel load for the Waterford-3 Nuclear Plant Unit.

2. Work Requirements

The contractor will supply two consultants with expertise in the area of quality assurance operations to assist the resident inspector in performing a QA inspection at Waterford Unit 3 in St. Charles, Louisiana for compliance with IE Manual Chapter 2513, "QA Manuals" issued January 1, 1984. These consultants will be part of a team that is completing inspection modules 35740-35750. The team will perform the inspection and provide written input for the inspection report to the resident inspector (L. Constable). The inspection report will be revised, if necessary, to incorporate IE comments.

3. Estimated Level of Effort

It is estimated that two staff-weeks of effort for each consultant will be required to accomplish the requested assistance. The consultants are required to be at the Waterford-3 site in St. Charles, Louisiana for performing this work.

4. Estimated Period of Performance

May 14, 1984 through May 25, 1984.

5. Cost Amount - CPFF Task Order

The Total Estimated Amount of this Task Order shall be \$16,198.96 of which \$15,816.32 represents the estimated cost and \$382.64 represents the fixed fee.
