By letter dated March 1, 1995, you applied for an amendment to the South Texas Project, Unit 1 Facility Operating License No. NPF-76. The proposed change would have modified the facility technical specifications pertaining to the use of an alternate plugging criteria (known in the industry as F\*) on steam generator tubes that are defective or degraded within certain areas within the tubesheet. Subsequently, by letter dated September 7, 1995, you withdrew the amendment request.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
