SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY - CURRENT TECHNICAL ACTIVITIES,
ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES AND LONG RANGE PLANNING

On January 30, 1992 John Zwolinski, John Hannon, Robert Samworth, and James Gavula of NRC met with Ed Lipke, Harve Hanneman, and Doug Johnson of Wisconsin Electric Power Company at NRC headquarters in Rockville. The purpose of the meeting was for WEPCo to inform NRC of current technical activities for which WEPCo's Nuclear Technical Services Section has responsibility. WEPCo staff also told NRR about recent management activities potentially relevant to nuclear safety. A copy of the agenda is attached.

* IPA/PRA/IPEEE - WEPCo is experiencing difficulty in obtaining a quality product from their contractor in a timely manner. They may revise their schedule for reporting to NRC. Harve Hanneman will come back to NRR in about six months to provide a more detailed status report.

* Station blackout status/diesels/gas turbine - The design of the two new emergency diesel generators is nearing completion as are plans for testing. By April WEPCo expects to be prepared to make a formal presentation to the staff.

Additional modifications of the gas turbine are planned to further improve reliability. These modifications should be complete and six weeks of testing will be conducted before WEPCo will conclude whether they will meet this aspect of the station blackout rule on schedule. By late May they would like to make a formal presentation to NRC. NRR advised WEPCo to not wait that long to give us the details of their program if there is any likelihood that they will not meet their commitments under the rule.

* WEPCo has completed a review of their technical specifications following a commitment made in conjunction with inspection report 91-25. They expect to submit license amendment applications as identified in their review within about one year.

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* Mr. Lipke discussed organizational changes in his Section of WEPCo, the WEPCo business plan, related longer term expectations, and their focus for 1992. WEPCo intends to provide NRC with more detail on evolving activities in the future than they have in past years.
