Dear Mr. Beatty:

This is in response to your letter of April 25, 1984 to Commissioner Victor Gilinsky in favor of the licensing of the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station.

The Shoreham proceeding is not now before the Commissioners for adjudication on the merits. Rather, various panels of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board have various aspects of LILCO's operating license application before them in formal hearings. An order regarding the proceeding before one of these panels on LILCO's request for a low power (5% of rated power) license is enclosed. Should favorable licensing decisions be made, no license can be issued in this case without Commission approval.

I trust this information and the enclosed order are of interest to you. In accordance with standard practice your letter and this reply are being served on the parties to the Shoreham proceeding.
