This refers to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection conducted by Mr. William Orders of this office on December 11, 1991 - January 11, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Catawba facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed inspection report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

As a result of this inspection, two violations were identified involving configuration control problems associated with the operation of the 2B Containment Spray Pump without a suction source and an inadvertent main turbine roll which occur ed during post-modification testing of the new turbine control system. These two issues are considered additional examples of an apparent violation identified in NRC inspection Report Nos. 50-413/91-27 and 50-414/91-27, which will be discussed in future correspondence.

The enclosed Inspection Report also identifies activities that appeared to violate NRC requirements that are not cited; therefore, a response is not required.
