Dear Mr. Horn:

By letter dated August 31, 1993, the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) applied for amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-46 for the Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS). The proposed changes would have modified the facility technical specifications pertaining to the standby gas treatment system, secondary containment, and primary containment isolation valves.

Subsequently, NPPD determined that it would not pursue this issue; and, in a telephone conversation on September 14, 1995, between Mr. Robert Godley of your staff and me, Mr. Godley confirmed that NPPD planned to withdraw the amendment. Unless you notify us that our understanding is incorrect by October 2, 1995, we will consider the application as withdrawn and will file a Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication and close this action.
