SUBJECT: COOPER NUCLEAR STATION - WITHDRAWAL OF LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUESTS
(TAC NOS. M75939, M87256, M87727, M88542, AND M88543)

Dear Mr. Horn:

By letters dated January 26, 1990, and August 23, August 31, September 28 and December 10, 1993, the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) applied for amendments to Facility Operating License No. DPR-46 for the Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS).

The proposed changes would have modified the facility technical specifications to revise: safety valve and safety relief valve setpoint tolerances; the Administrative Controls section position titles and organization; the requirements for primary containment isolation instrumentation and valves; and the pressure/temperature operating limit curves.

Subsequently, by letter dated September 8, 1995, NPPD withdrew these amendment requests. In that letter, Mr. John Mueller, CNS Site Manager, indicated that NPPD is considering implementation of the Improved Standard Technical Specifications (ISTS), and that these previous submittals do not conform to the guidance and format of the ISTS. We further understand that the content of the proposed changes withdrawn by your September 8, 1995 letter will be reviewed and considered for inclusion in any future submittals implementing the ISTS.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Applications for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication. A Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment

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
