NRC Region III has received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) letter dated October 7, 1991, and the associated final exercise evaluation report of the offsite portion of the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant's emergency preparedness exercise conducted on June 5-6, 1991. The State of Missouri and the counties of Callaway, Gasconade, Montgomery and Osage fully participated in the exercise.

FEMA identified three deficiencies and nine Arcas Requiring Corrective Actions (ARCAs) during the exercise. Based on the results of the exercise and a review of the subsequent corrective actions to the identified deficiencies, FEMA determined that the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness site-specific to the Callaway facilities are adequate to protect public health and safety in the event of a radiological emergency at the Callaway Plant. As a result, the approval of offsite radiological emergency response plans for the Callaway Plant will remain in effect, in accordance with rEMA Rule Title 44 CFR Part 350.

You are requested to interact with offsite officials to resolve any ourstanding concerns identified by FEMA.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
