Centlemen:

By letter dated June 13, 1991, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment Nos. 153 and 183 to the Facility Operating Licenses for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2, respectively. Among the changes approved by these amendments was a one-time, 18 month exception to the requirement for the Manager-Operations to hold, or have held, a Senior Reactor Operator (SRO) anse for either the Brunswick Plant or a similar unit.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Staff that effective February 6, 1992, Mr. Keith J. Ahern assumed the Manager-Onerations position. N.r. Ahern, who recently served as the Manager-Regulatory Compliance, currently holds an SRO license for the Brunswick Plant. Mr. John Moyer, the current Manager-Operations, will be assuming the Manager-Nuclear Assessment position at the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant. Carolina Power & Light Company reiterates its appreciation of the one-time exception to allow for the development of a strong manager to assume the duties of Manager-Operations.
