





Gulf States Utilities Company has completed its evaluation of DR-162 concerning nuisance tripping of A80L10 trip coils supplied by Gould and has determined that the trip coil setting information for Motor Control Center setpoint data did not reflect the \pm 0 percent manufacturing tolerances. The setpoint data has been appropriately revised. Because no deficiency exists, this condition does not meet the reporting requirements of 10CFR 50.55(e).
