Dear Sir:

By your Reference (1) letter you transmitted Staff questions resulting from review of the Waterford 3 PGP. Those questions identified as fuel load requirements were resolved by LP&L's Reference (2) response.

Resolution to the remaining questions, and resubmittal of the PGP, was required by June 30, 1984 based upon the expected license condition to complete the PGP one month prior to exceeding 5% power. Because of dedication of personnel resources to other areas (e.g. Fire Protection, Remote Shutdown Procedure) and the uncertainty in fuel load schedule, LP&L requests an extension to July 31 for resubmittal of the PGP. This schedule will more than satisfy the previously mentioned license condition and may well obviate the need for such a condition.
