> Percy Nuclear Power Plant Docket No. 50-441 Change in Ownership of PNPP Unit 2

Gentlemen:

On October 28, 1991, we submitted to you a request in letter PY-CEI/NRR-1377L to extend the Perry Nuclear Pow'r Plan' (PNPP) Unit 2 Construction Permit No. CPPR-149. That application was filed by the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) on behalf of itself, Ohio Edison Company, Pennsylvania Power Company and Toledo Edison Company. The application stated that co-permittee, Duquesne Light Company (DLC), had previously announced that it would "initiate a 'de facto' abandonment for ratemaking purposes" of its interest in Unit 2. The abandonment decision was based on approval from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission allowing DLC to amortize and recover its investment on Unit 2 on the basis that it had abandoned its interest in that unit.

As we have previously informed the NRC Staff, CEI and DLC have been negotiating to formally transfer DLC's ownership share of Unit 2 to CEI. That transfer is now complete. With this transfer, CEI's ownership interest in Unit 2 has increased from 31.11% to 44.85% and DLC no longer holds an interest in Unit 2. The ownership interests of Toledo Edison Company, Ohio Edison Company and Pennsylvania Power Company in Unit 2 remain unchanged.

This information has been provided to assist in your review of our Construction Permit Extension request and to identify the revised Unit 2 Ownership holders related to that application. If you have any questions, please feel free to call.
