2. copies of all correspondence, safety assessments, meeting minutes, reports, etc. related to risks and activities associated with Shutdown and Low Power Operations provided to the USNRC from OECD/NEA Committee for Nuclear Activities (CNRA) and its ad hoc working groups on shutdown and low power issues; and
3. copies of all completed NRC staff documents, safety assessments, meeting minutes, reports, etc. related to risk and activities associated with Shutdown and Low Power Operations that, in and of themselves, would not constitute new requirements or be considered predecisional.

If copies of any of the aforementioned documents are not available because they are considered predecisional, please provide at a minimum a listing of those documents and the date of issuance.

Should any of the aforementioned documents not made available because they are considered proprietary, please provide at a minimum the non-proprietary portions of those documents. For those portions which may be considered proprietary, please provide a listing of all proprietary documents and copies of associated NRC determinations performed and documented pursuant to 10 CFR 2.790 and/or 10 CFR 9.17.

Please advise should this request, or any portion thereof, require an expenditure in excess of \$200.00.
