## AMENDMENT TO FACILITY LICENSE

License No. R-86 Amendment No. 1

License No. R-86 is hereby amended to authorize the changes described in the application amendment dated July 25, 1962.

Paragraph 1. of License No. R-86 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. This license applies to the Radiation Effects Reactor (RER), a heterogeneous pressurized water-type nuclear reactor (Air Force Plant No. 67) (hereinafter referred to as "the reactor") which is possessed by the Department of the Air Force and located on a 10,000 acre site in Dawson County, Georgia, and described in the Lockheed Aircraft Corporation application for license dated February 23, 1962, and amendments thereto dated April 20, 1962, May 25, 1962 and July 25, 1962, and described in the Department of the Air Force application for license dated March 15, 1962 and April 11, 1962, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the applications"). The reactor was constructed for the Department of the Air Force as a facility exempt from AEC licensing requirements under Section 91b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended."

This amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.
