Amendment No. 3 to License No. B-86, issued to Lockheed Aircraft Corporation, which requires the installation of a present water reflector on one side of the aircraft and an aluminum reflector, and (2) to reduce the number of stations from 10 stations within and 7 stations outside the perimeter fence, to 9 stations within and 3 stations outside of the perimeter fence, as described in the application for license amendment dated February 27, 1963.

Also enclosed is a copy of a notice of this action, which has been published in the Office of the Federal Register, and a Hazard Analysis of the proposed amendment.
