Subject: LICENSEE PROPOSES HALTING ALL CONSTRUCTION AT MIDLAND

Consumers Power Company officials have indicated they will recommend to the utility's Directors that all work at the Midland Nuclear project be halted. The recommendation is expected to be made at the Board of Directors 9 a.m. meeting June 27, 1984 in Jackson, Michigan.

Officials said they arrived at their decision after negotiations broke off with a coalition of state, community and public interest groups June 26, 1984, in Jackson. The licensee had been meeting with the coalition in an attempt to reach an agreement on future financing of the Midland project.

There has been news media interest in the proposed recommendation. Region III (Chicago) is responding to inquiries.

The State of Michigan will be notified.
