Gentlemen:

By letter dated April 12, 1971, you applied for authority to dispose of certain components from the Radiation Effects Reactor (RER), which you possess in accordance with License No. R-86, and for authority to decommission the reactor. We have reviewed your application; and we find that the disposal of components and decommissioning of the reactor as proposed will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public. Therefore, in accordance with Section 50.82 of 10 CFR 50, you are authorized to proceed with decommissioning and disposal as proposed. After notification from you that Sections B and D of the proposed decommissioning plan have been executed and after an inspection of the facility by the Division of Compliance, we will consider issuing a further order terminating License No. R-86 concurrent with the issuance of a Byproduct Material License by the State of Georgia.

A copy of the enclosed order authorizing the dismantling of the facility has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
