SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING WITH GE TO DISCUSS THE ABWR HUMAN FACTORS

PROGRAM

On January 7-9, 1992, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with GE in San Jose, California, to discuss human factors issues for the ABWR review. Generally, the meeting was productive, and a path to closure for the remaining open issues was discussed.

The proposed meeting in Japan was also discussed. The Joint Studies conducted by GE, Hitachi, and Toshiba will be the mechanism for confirming the adequacy of some of the key features of the ABWR man-machine interface (MMI) design. GE briefly discussed the Joint Studies evaluations, including the use of videotape analysis techniques of operator control room activities. The staff would like to review the evaluation methods and conclusions in greater detail, as part of the proposed meeting in Japan.

GE agreed to the following:

- To complete the actions listed in the body of the enclosed meeting summary.
- To prepare a summary of their relevant experience using the ABWR proposed design process for the upcoming NRC/GE management meeting on January 28-29, 1992, in San Jose, California.
- To provide responses to all Human Factors draft safety evaluation report open items by February 28, 1992.
