LOCKHEED AIRCRAFT CORPORATION (RER), LICENSE NO. R-86, DOCKET NO. 50-172

The attached report of a special announced inspection of the subject facility by our inspector on July 14, 1971, is forwarded for information. There were no items of safety significance or noncompliance observed.

Based on the results of this inspection, Region II has determined that the RER has been decommissioned in accordance with Sections B and D of the Lockheed Decommissioning Plan, dated April 12, 1971. (Information was provided in Region II TWX to Compliance Headquarters dated July 15, 1971.) Region II recommends that AEC License No. R-86 be terminated and that concurrently with termination of License No. R-86, that all concerned areas of the facility be placed under a State of Georgia Byproduct Materials License.
