This confirms verbal authorization provided to you on August 31. 1995 to continue work under the subject task order as modified with a ceiling amount of \$59.492.

Task Order referenced above was awarded on May 5, 1995 in the amount of \$59,492. The purpose of this modification is to increase the funding to allow for an increase in scope of work to include preparation of six simulator scenarios and administration of nine operator exams. The increase in scope will require an additional two examiners onsite during exam week.

As a result of this action, funding in the amount of \$8.613 (
representing total estimated costs, representing FCCM, and
representing profit or fee) is hereby provided which increases the obligated
amount from \$59,492 to \$68,105.
