

Dear Judge Bloch:

I have been advised by representatives of the Executive Legal Director's Office that the intervenors have represented that the MRC's Office of Investigations (OI) has a preference that affidavits, statements, etc., from certain witnesses not be provided to the parties. As a general proposition, OI does not advocate the sharing of the fruits of ongoing investigations outside the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. One of OI's concerns is that the premature release of investigative information may prejudice the successful completion of a investigative product.

OI is unclear as to what individuals and/or statements the intervenors are referring. Consequently, without such information, OI is unable to express its views regarding this particular matter. Upon receipt of such specific information, OI will respond to the Board.
