TMI Restart 1 - In an unpublished order issued on December 22, the Board in the management phase granted the motion of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to withdraw its appeal. It also approved a stipulation between the Commonwealth and the licensee that, in the event restart is authorized, the licensee will not (i) employ at TMI-1 any individuals found to have cheated on any licensing or training exam, or (ii) use an individual designated as DD to operate TMI-1 or train operating license holders or trainees. Finally, the Board dismissed as moot the request of two former TMI employees (designated as O and VV) to intervene in the appellate proceedings because no party has asked that action be taken against either. All procedural steps before oral argument are now complete and I do not anticipate any activity in the case before' January 11.
