SUBJECT: APPEAL PANEL STATUS REPORT (AS OF
DECEMBER 31, 1983)

Three Mile Island 1 (Restart) - In an unpublished order issued on December 22, the Appeal Board granted the motion of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to withdraw its appeal in the management phase of this proceeding. The Board also approved a stipulation between the Commonwealth and the licensee that, in the event restart is authorized, the licensee will not (i) employ at TMI-1 any individuals found to have cheated on any licensing or training exam, or (ii) use an individual designated as DD to operate TMI-1 or train operating license holders or trainees. Finally, the Board dismissed as moot the request of two former TMI employees (designated as O and VV) to intervene in the appellate proceedings because no party has asked that action be taken against either of those individuals.

As previously reported, the oral argument on the pending issues in the management phase will be held on January 11 in Bethesda.
