Three Mile Island 1 (Restart) - On March 7, intervenors Majorie and Norman Aamodt filed a petition for reconsideration of ALAB-697 (October 22, 1982) dealing with emergency planning issues. (The Commission has declined to review ALAB-697.) On March 22, the licensee filed an answer asserting that the Appeal Board no longer has jurisdiction over this phase of the case. Under established Appeal Board practice, responses to petitions for reconsideration are not required unless specifically requested. The Appeal Board made no such request in this instance and the staff has indicated to the Board that it does not intend to file an answer. A ruling on the petition should be forthcoming this week.
