TMI Restart - Oral argument in the management phase of the case was held on January 11, and this aspect of the proceeding (apart from the Hartman allegations of leak rate falsification at Unit 2, which we reopened last August) is ready for decision.

The Aamodts filed a motion on January 24 to reopen the record to examine the issue of leak rate falsification at Unit 1. (In this connection, on Friday, January 27, the Commission issued its tentative views and plan for resolution of management issues prior to restart, observing that it believes that "the only ongoing investigation which may require further resolution before a decision on the management issues is the Unit 1 leak rate investigation.") Answers to the Aamodt's motion are due on February 8 (licensee, other parties) and February 15 (staff).
