The following deviation was identified during an inspection conducted on April 11-12, 1984.

In the Proposed Emergency Plan submitted to NRC by a letter of November 3, 1982, the licensee stated that the AGN-201 reactor would be disassembled on November 11, 1982, and that full decommissioning was anticipated to take place in early 1983.

Contrary to the above, the licensee has not disassembled the reactor nor taken any action to begin the process of decommissioning the reactor, and further, has neglected to inform the Commission of this change in plans.

Please provide, in writing within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a description of corrective actions regarding this deviation, actions taken to avoid further deviations, and the dates when these actions were or will be completed.
