Dear Mr. Sugarman:

This letter is to express our concern that you may have failed to exercise reasonable care in assuring complete service of material you sent to Chairman Palladino on all of the parties to the Limerick Generating Station operating license proceeding. William L. Clements, Chief of NRC Docketing and Service Branch, informed you that such materials are <u>ex parte</u> communications prohibited by 10 C.F.R. 2.780 unless served on the parties. As a result, you served your letter to Chairman Palladino on the parties but may not have included the enclosures to the letter, which were also <u>ex parte</u> communications.

In order to assure compliance with the regulations, the NRC is serving on the appropriate Boards and parties your letter to Chairman Palladino with its enclosures and a copy of this letter.
