MEMORANDUM AND ORDER  
(Motion to Compel Staff Testimony)

Citizens Association for Sound Energy (CASE) filed a July 2, 1984, motion to compel testimony from three members of the Staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Motion). The extraordinary circumstances said to call for production of these witnesses was their participation in two meetings held in November 1982 with Mr. Dennis Culton. However, Mr. Culton's affidavit, filed by CASE on August 3, 1983, indicates that CASE has tape recordings that are direct evidence of those meetings. Hence, CASE has not indicated any way in which these witness's testimony would add materially to evidence already available. See 10 CFR § 2.720(h)(2)(i).


ORDER
