ORDER

On July 1, 1984 Three Mile Island Alert filed a motion with the Commission requesting an extension until July 12, 1984 to file its response to licensee's Petition for Review of ALAB-772. The Commission has granted that request. All parties to the proceeding are to serve their responses so that they are received by the Commission by c.o.b. July 12.

The NRC staff on July 3, 1984 filed a motion requesting that it be given until July 19, 1984 to submit its comments responding to the Commission's June 1, 1984 Order which requested the parties views on whether the management concerns which led to making the 1979 shutdown Order immediately effective have been resolved. If the Commission's Office of Investigations (OI) has not provided its last report to the staff by July 16, 1984, then the staff requests that its response be due on the third business day following its receipt of the last OI report.



The Union of Concerned Scientists and the Aamodts requested that if the staff request is granted, that they be given an extension of time which would permit them to review the last OI report before submitting their comments.

The Commission anticipates that the OI reports will be available to the parties shortly after July 16, 1984. The Commission has determined that it is appropriate to grant an extension of time which will permit the parties to file a response to the Commission's June 1, 1984 Order, which addresses all pertinent OI reports. Accordingly, the responses to the Commission's June 1, 1984 Order from all of the parties, including the NRC staff, are to be received by the Commission by noon, July 26, 1984.

It is so ORDERED.*
