Dear Mrs. Ellis:

This is in response to your petition of January 28, 1983, on behalf of Citizens Association for Sound Energy (CASE), requesting that I exercise my authority under 10 CFR 2.202 to issue an order to the licensees of the Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, Units 1 and 2, to show cause why they should not have to provide certain ITT Grinnell and NPSI design criteria used for pipe supports at Comanche Peak, or in the alternative, if these documents are not in the licensees' possession, why the licensees are not in violation of NRC regulations.

For the reasons set forth in the enclosed "Director's Decision under 10 CFR 2.206" your petition has been denied. However, it is my understanding that you have been permitted access to the identified documents as a result of further negotiations with the licensees over discovery matters in connection with the operating license proceeding.

A copy of the decision will be filed with the Secretary of the Commission; for its review in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206(c) of the Commission's regulations. As provided by this regulation, the decision will constitute the final action of the Commission 25 days after the date of issuance of the decision unless the Commission, on its own motion, institutes a review of the decision within that time.

A copy of a notice, which is being filed with the Office of the Federal Registe for publication, is also enclosed. I also enclose a copy of a letter from counsel for the licensees to staff counsel which is referenced in the decision.


