REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL

INTERIM FINDINGS FOR CATAWBA NUCLEAR STATION

We have completed our review of the May 8, 1984 FEMA interim finding report on the status of offsite radiological plans and preparedness for the Catawba Nuclear Station.

Your memo did not include a statement indicating the adequacy of the State and local emergency plans. However, as indicated in your memo, changes to the emergency response plans and/or a schedule of corrective actions from each State in response to the RAC's comments have been forwarded to you from FEMA Region IV. Therefore, in accordance with FEMA/NRC Memorandum of Understanding, we are requesting further FEMA review and supplemental interim findings, indicating the adequacy of the offsite plans for Catawba.

In order to meet the licensing schedule and avoid impacting the applicant's projected date for operation, responses to our requests should be provided by June 15, 1984.
