SUBJECT: Notification of Unusual Event Due to Apparent Fire

At 1330 on 9/1/84 the site fire brigade and local fire department were called because of an apparent fire in the wellhouse. It was subsequently determined that a fire did not occur, but smoke had resulted from a lube oil leak on the diesel-driven fire pump, which was operating at the time. The licensee subsequently declared and terminated a notification of unusual event. The plant was operating at 66% power and was not affected by the event.
