Illinois Power Company hereby files Amendment No. 31 dated September, 1984 for the Clinton Final Safety Analysis Report (CP. FSAR). FSAR Amendment No. 31 presents changes that update and clarify information. The major changes consist of:

- a) Updating of information in Section 3.11, Environmental Qualification of Electrical Equipment; and
- b) Revisions to Chapter 13 to refer to the Clinton Power Station Emergency Plan, Revision 3, as a separate document, which has previously been sent to the commission. This is in accordance with Regulatory Guide 1.70, Revision 3.




