Inspection Summary

Inspection on June 11-15, 1984 (Reports No. 50-266/84-08(DRSS); 50-301/84-06(DRSS))
Areas Inspected: Included a review of the Licensee's Action on Previous Inspection Findings; Security Plan and Implementing Procedures; Management Effectiveness - Security Program; Security Organization, Security Program Audit; Records and Reports; Testing and Maintenance; Security System Power Supply; Compensatory Measures; Access Control - Personnel Detection Aids - Protected and Vital Areas; Alarm Stations; Communications; and Independent Inspection. The inspection involved 64 inspector-hours by two NRC inspectors. Eight of the 64 inspector-hours were conducted offsite during offshift periods. The inspection began during the day shift.

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Results: The licensee was found to be in compliance with NRC requirements within the areas examined, except for the following item:

Alarm Station: A computer capability required by the security plan could be circumvented.

An area of concern was noted regarding written guidance by the security contractor pertaining to the reporting of possible violations to the NRC. Four commitments were made to resolve other concerns noted during the inspection. These concerns did not constitute violations of NRC requirements.

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
