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REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY RESEARCH REACTOR OPERATOR REQUALIFICATION PROGRAM

- (1) The licensed operator requalification program must include preplanned lectures. Subjects to be considered as lecture topics are listed in 10 CFR 55.59 (c)(2). Preplanned lectures are not part of the program provided for review. What preplanned lectures are included as part of the Iowa State University licensed operator requalification program?
- (2) The program's examination and operating test topics are not consistent with the topics stated in 10 CFR 55.41, 10 CFR 55.43, 10 CFR 55.45, and required by 10 CFR 55.59(a)(2). How do the examination and test topics described in the program meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 55?
- (3) Section 6.1 of the program describes actions to be taken in the event an operator achieves a total score of less than 70 percent. According to the program, the actions to be taken are found in section 6.1.1 of the program. Section 6.1.1 is not in the requalification program plan submitted. What is the correct reference?
- (4) The program does not address all of the requirements of 10 CFR 55.53(e). Where does the program ensure the qualifications and status of the operator whose license is being reinstated are both current and valid?
